

DENTAPOINT Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy applies to all websites operated by or on behalf of DENTAPOINT Company, branded websites on third-party platforms (such as Facebook and YouTube), and applications accessed or used through these websites or third-party programs ("DENTAPOINT"). By using DENTAPOINT and its sub-link sites, you consent to the use of cookies in accordance with this Cookie Policy. If you do not wish for cookies to be used in this manner, you should adjust your browser settings or refrain from using DENTAPOINT sites. Disabling the cookies we use may affect your user experience on DENTAPOINT sites.

What are Cookie Practices?

Cookies are files or pieces of information that may be stored on your computer (or other internet-enabled devices such as smartphones and tablets) when you visit a DENTAPOINT site. A cookie typically contains the name of the website from which it originated, the "lifetime" of the cookie (i.e., how long it will be stored on your device), and a randomly generated unique number.

What Do We Use Cookies For?

We use cookies to make DENTAPOINT sites easier to use and to better tailor DENTAPOINT sites and our products to your interests and needs. Cookies can also be used to speed up your future activities and experiences on our sites. Additionally, we use cookies to compile anonymous, aggregated statistical data that helps us understand how people use our sites and to improve the structure and content of our sites.

How Do We Use Third-Party Cookies?

We may work with some third-party suppliers who set cookies on your device on our behalf when you visit DENTAPOINT sites, to deliver the services they provide. For detailed information about these cookies and how to opt out of receiving them, please refer to the relevant sections below.

As of the date of this notice, if you transition to other sites via a link from the DENTAPOINT site, the cookie information obtained from those sites falls under the responsibility of the third-party websites or applications. It is advisable that you review the cookie policies of these third parties during your visits to their sites.

How Can I Control or Delete Cookies?

Most internet browsers are set to automatically accept cookies by default. You can modify these settings to block cookies or to alert you when cookies are being sent to your device. There are several ways to manage cookies. For detailed instructions on how to adjust your browser settings, please refer to your browser's instruction or help screen.

If you disable the cookies we use, this action may affect your user experience on DENTAPOINT sites; for instance, you may not be able to view certain parts of a DENTAPOINT site or access personalized information when you visit a DENTAPOINT site.

If you use different devices to view DENTAPOINT sites (e.g., computer, smartphone, tablet, etc.), you need to ensure that each browser on each device is adjusted to your cookie preferences.

Detailed Information on Types of Cookies

- Session/Temporary Cookies: These cookies are deleted from your device once you leave the website.
- Persistent/Permanent Cookies: These cookies are not deleted from your device once you leave the website; they remain stored on your device for a longer period.
